ANIMAL CONTROL ENFORCEMENT

Animal control program consists of 1 Supervisory Officer, Duane Clarke, 2 Field Officers, Shaun Henson and Jason Madrid, 2 Kennel Support officers, Alex Nish and Valan Quasula.

As of July 2013, Animal control has responded to over 3,000 calls, 2012 we have adopted out over 200 Animals, and have registered 237 Animals.

The responsibilities of each personnel, Supervisory Officer is responsible for the Daily operations of Program, community and agency outreach, prosecution of cases and conducts investigative follow ups on reports.

Field Officers are responsible for all field duties, public relations, public safety, rabies control, enforcing the Animal Control ordinance, snake and other predator removal.

Kennel support officers are assigned to Animal Care, they conduct Intake of rescued, captured animals, daily feeding and care of the kennels, also ensure the Adoption process as well as reclaiming process with owners and or interested people who wish to adopt!

Personnel not only strive in excellence of care and control of our animal population but serve as first responders with our Emergency Services Response Team.



PEACH SPRINGS FIRE

The Fire Department has an existing Emergency Response Team who provides assistance to the community members for unforeseen severe weather situations, such as extreme cold or heat, long term power outages or any natural or manmade disasters. We also perform fire and safety inspections of all businesses in the local area, upon request, the department can inspect private homes for fire and safety hazards. We assist with Search & Rescue for Tribal and Non-Tribal members within the boundaries of the Reservation, as well as assisting neighboring Havasupai Tribe for their natural disasters.

Fire Department is fully staffed with 2 Administrative personnel, Fire Chief Ron Quasula & Assistant Fire Administrator, Ava Bravo, 2 Full time Firefighters, Raymond Schnabel and Matthew Muromotto, & 7 Part time Firefighters, Kerwin Powsey, Chris Gortariz, Bryce Martens, Jason Lopez, Jesse Holmes, Mark Graham, and Joel Bradley. We implemented a 24 hour manned station in 2012 to ensure faster and proper coverage for the community.

The Fire department has a Mutual Aid agreement with Northern Consolidated Fire District of Kingman and Seligman Fire Department to ensure we assist both departments on and off the boundaries of the Hualapai Reservation. Our Fire Program conducts an annual physical agility testing to ensure all firefighter personnel are physically able to perform duties that is demanding of the job while on shift.

PEACH SPRINGS EMS

The EMS Department currently has a total of 15 Fulltime and 7 Part time employees. There are 3 designated crews A Shift, B Shift, C Shift, with 4 EMT's and 1 Paramedic, including 2 Ambulances and a 3rd on standby.

Our department offers CPR and Basic First Aid training to the community and all tribal departments.

All EMS employees are training once a week per shift on EKG, IV's, and Pediatrics exercises; we also attend multi agency trainings to keep up to date on new and upcoming changes in Local Protocols and practical skills and in addition helps to better our relations with other agencies that we respond mutual aid. EMS is happy to serve the community and surrounding areas of the reservation.
