



HUALAPAI NATION JOB ANNOUNCEMENT OPEN COMPETITIVE

JOB TITLE: Range Water Technician I

JOB SUMMARY:

This will be an introductory position within the Department of Natural Resources' Agriculture Program. The Range Water Technician I will be under the direct supervision of the Agriculture Program Assistant Manager. The Technician will assist in monitoring and ensuring water is flowing to laterals off the main West Water Pipeline on the west side of the reservation. Job duties will also include repair of galvanized and polyethylene water lines, replacement of air vents, gate valves, float assemblies, float covers and install wildlife ramps in troughs where needed. Most of the knowledge and training required of the position will be acquired on the job.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Assists in the maintenance and repair of waterlines, water line valves, pumps (booster and well) and storage tanks (steel, polyethylene and portable).
- Assists in the construction and installation of all aspects of new waterlines, water line valves, pumps (booster) and storage tanks, (steel, polyethylene and portable).
- Assists in other Natural Resource Department Program's projects as assigned.
- Assists in conducting surveys, inventories and assessments of entire water system on the West Side of the Reservation.
- Must be willing to learn and receive training on working with a variety of water pipes including steel, galvanized, pvc and polyethylene pipes.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIREMENTS:

- High School Diploma or G.E.D. Equivalent.
- Must be a team player to integrate with other programs within the Department.
- Must be willing to attend and receive training related to the position.
- Must be able to work under any weather conditions, be in good physical condition and able to remain in the field for extended periods of time, up to 10 hour days and weekends as necessary.
- Must be able to lift between 80-100 lbs and able to carry bulky items such as several sticks or rolls of pipe (10 feet to 21 feet in length (3/4" diameter – 3" in diameter).
- Must have a valid Driver License and be eligible for Tribe's insurance.

- Submit to and pass a pre employment and random drug/alcohol screening
