OPERATION PASSENGER CARRIER STRIKE FORCE

On July 22-23 and July 29-30, 2015, the Hualapai Nation Police Department in partnership with the Arizona Department of Public Safety, and the Arizona Department of Transportation, participated in the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Alliance's (FMCSA) Operation Passenger Carrier Strike Force. The strike force operation was conducted at the Hualapai Nation's Grand Canyon West.

The mission of "Operation Passenger Carrier Strike Force" was to ensure that commercial passenger vehicles and drivers are in compliance with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, State, and Tribal Regulations. Research has demonstrated that driver behavior and fatigue are the most common factors in crashes amongst passenger commercial motor vehicles.

Operation Strike Force conducted was a complete success and the results are as follows:

Total Inspections Completed: 170
Total FMCSA violations located: 243
Total driver violations: 87
Total driver's placed out of service: 7
Total vehicle violations: 156
Total vehicle's placed out of service: 13
Total traffic citations issued: 28
