ADDENDUM NO. 1

Response to General Questions

1. *The RFP indicates that the "primary mission" of the HTUA is to serve the electric utility needs of Grand Canyon West. Does this proposal also include Peach Springs? Yes, please include the Peach Springs community currently being served by Mohave Electric Cooperative in the Cost of Service study.*
2. *The scope of work asks to "review existing customer classifications and available load data." What type of existing rate details and load data is available? Is the load data individualized or in aggregate? Load and usage is available for each commercial meter month by month. Residential usage is available for each meter month by month. Mohave Electric Cooperative will provide this information for a fee. The current rate structure and demand charges by type of customer are also available from MEC.*
3. *Who currently operates the off-grid system at Grand Canyon West? Does Hualapai have access to all cost inputs? The tribe operates the mini-grid at Grand Canyon West and has access to the cost inputs.*
