(A FEDERALLY CHARTERED INDIAN CORPORATION)
PEACH SPRINGS, ARIZONA

DESTRUCTION OF WILD DOGS

Be it enacted by the Hualapai Tribal Council in Regular Meeting assembled on April 10, 1976, and in accordance with ARTICLE VI - "POWERS OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL", of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Hualapai Tribe of the Hualapai Reservation, Arizona, the following articles of Ordinance regulating the destroying of wild dogs:

ARTICLE I

Section 1. All dogs found to be unlicensed and roaming at will outside a two mile radius of the boundary of the community of Peach Springs, shall be considered to be wild dogs and subject to destruction.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of the Law Enforcement arm of the Hualapai Tribal Council and the Hualapai Tribal Wildlife and Outdoor Recreation Department to destroy such animals in the most effective and humane manner and to dispose of the remains, in a sanitary manner.


CERTIFICATION

The foregoing Ordinance was duly adopted on May 22, 1957, by the Hualapai Tribal Council by a vote of 6 for and 1 against, with 8 members present, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1. (c) and Article V, Section 6, of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Hualapai Tribe of the Hualapai Reservation, Arizona. This ordinance shall be subject to conditions as set forth in Article VII, of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Hualapai Tribe.
