

ORDINANCE NO. 8-59

WHEREAS, The Hualapai Tribal Council has the power under Article VI, Section 1, (c) to enact ordinances, subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior, establishing and governing Tribal Courts and Law enforcement on the Reservation; and


WHEREAS, the Hualapai Tribal Council desires to effect the efficient administration of Law and Order within the confines of the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, it appears desirable to enact an Ordinance controlling the sale, possession and use of explosives,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Hualapai Tribe meeting in regular session at Peach Springs, Arizona, this 2nd day of May, 1959; that any person who maliciously deposits, or explodes, or who attempts to explode, at, in, under or near any building, vessel, boat, railroad, or any train or car or any depot, stable, car-house, theater, schoolhouse, church, dwelling house or other place where human beings usually inhabit, assemble, frequent or pass, any chemical compound or explosive, with intent to injure or destroy such building, vessel, boat or other structure, or with intent to injure, intimidate or terrify a human being, or by means of which a human being is injured or endangered, is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment in the Hualapai Tribal Jail for not less than six months, nor more than one year.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Hualapai Tribal Council, hereby certify that the Tribal Council of the Hualapai Tribe is composed of nine (9) members of whom 7 constituting a quorum; were present at a regular meeting thereof this 2nd day of May, 1959; and that the foregoing Ordinance was duly adopted by the affirmative vote of 6 members.
