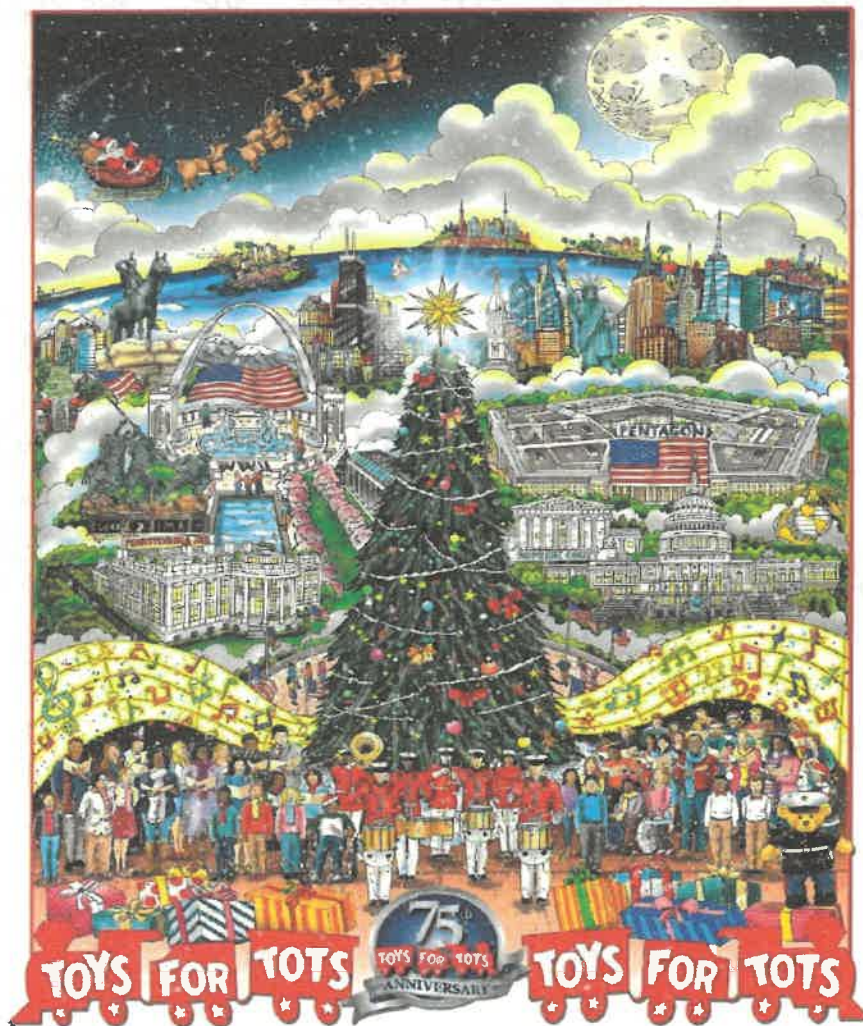

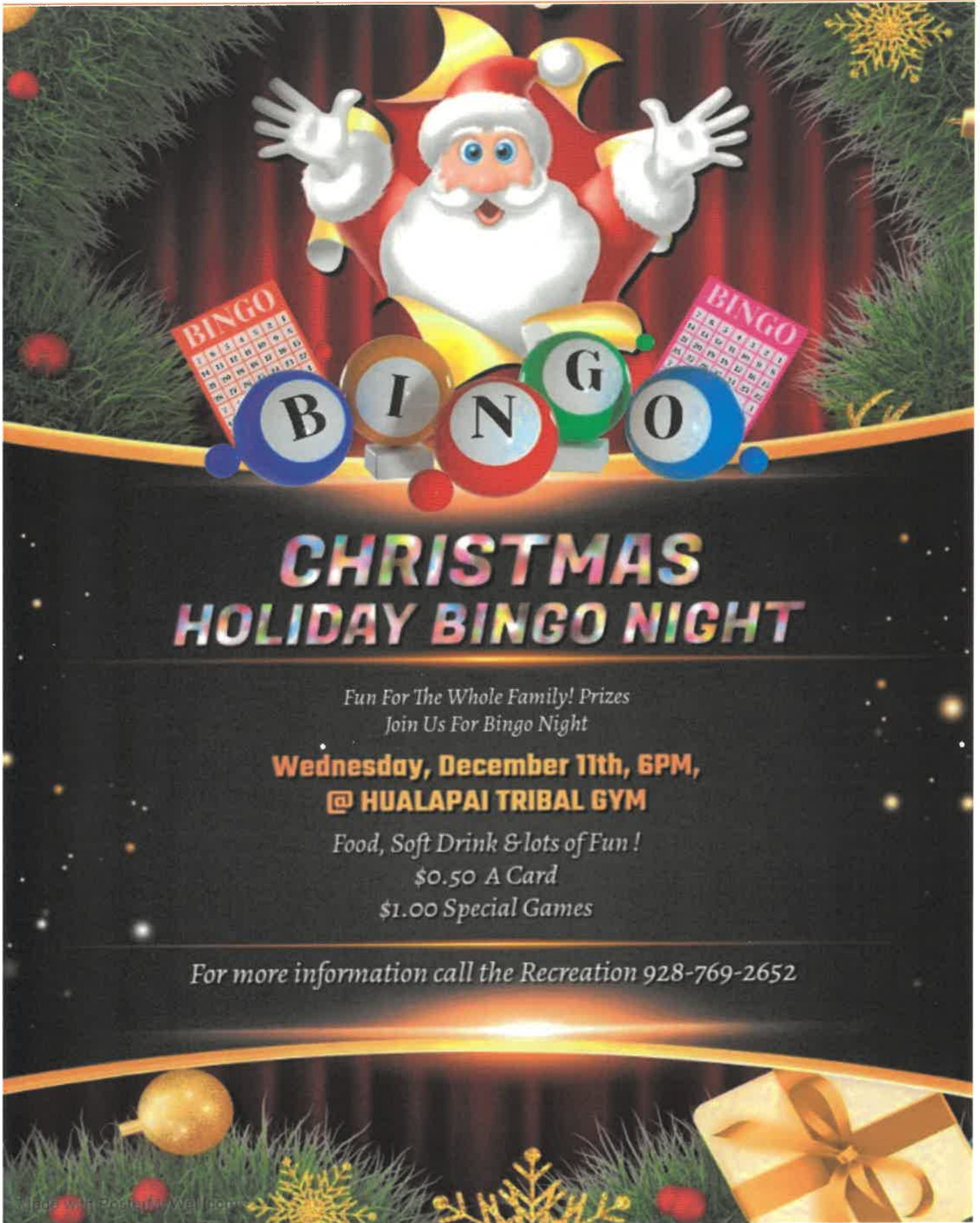

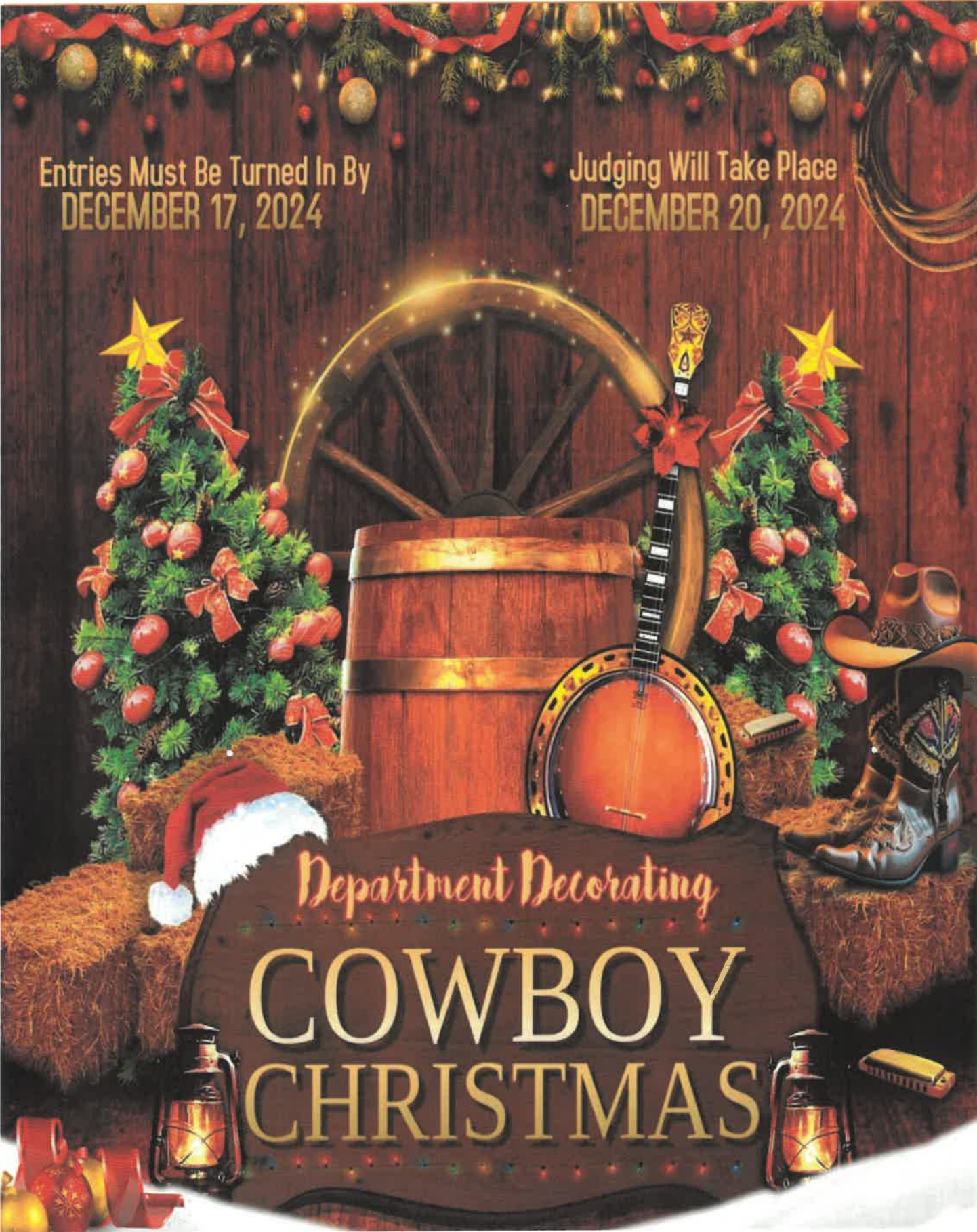

**Housing Improvement Program (HIP) Applications**

The BIA, Housing Improvement Program (HIP), also known as Housing Program (HP), seeks to enhance the quality of life of qualified individuals by addressing sub-standard housing and homelessness for members of federally recognized Tribes. The program provides grant funding for housing repairs and renovations of existing homes, construction of modest replacement homes, housing down payments to use in conjunction with other Federal and State programs, or construction of modest homes for families who do not own a home but have ownership or lease of sufficient land suitable for housing. Program funding is available to federally recognized Tribes for use in providing program services to Tribal applicants who meet the eligibility criteria in 25 CFR § 256. The HP targets eligible applicants and is based upon a priority ranking that includes factors such as income, age, veterans, disability, and dependent children.

## ***Four HIP Categories Available for Housing Assistance***

**Category (A)** Up to \$7,500 in housing repairs for health and safety threatening conditions

**Category (B)** Up to \$60,000 to raise the conditions of a house up to building code standards.

**Category (C-1)** Provides a modest replacement home when it is not possible to bring a home up to building code standards.

**Category (C-2)** Provides a modest new home for those who do not own a home. You may also be eligible for this type of aid if you are the owner of land suitable for housing or the leaseholder for land suitable for housing and the lease is for more than 25 years when assistance is received.

**Category (D)** Down Payment Assistance (DPA) helps tribal homebuyers with grants and low-interest loans that reduce the amount they need to purchase a home and reduces the monthly mortgage payment amount.

# ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

- Can you answer **YES** to all of the following:
  - ◆ Are you a member of a federally recognized Native American Tribe, or an Alaska Native?
  - ◆ Live in an approved tribal service area?
  - ◆ Have a **combined** household income at/ below 150% of DHHS Poverty Income Guidelines?
  - ◆ Your present housing is substandard or Homeless?
  - ◆ Own your home or land, or have a 25yr Residential leasehold (undivided)?
  - ◆ Have no other resource for housing assistance?
  - ◆ Have **never received HIP** assistance?
  - ◆ Did no acquire your present house through other federal program within the previous 20 years.

**Pick up an application from your local Tribal servicing office.**

## SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION ALONG WITH THESE DOCUMENTS:

- ⇒ Tribal Membership copies for all household members
- ⇒ Proof of all household members Income (W-2's, SSI, Disability, IIM, Per-Capita, etc.)
- ⇒ Proof of Home or Land ownership, or Leasehold
- ⇒ Proof of Disability, if applicable
- ⇒ Proof of Veterans status, if applicable
- ⇒ Denial Letter from other program you applied
- ⇒ Signed Privacy Act Statement
- ⇒ Signed HIP Certification
- ⇒ Approved Letter of Credit, from the program applied for mortgage financing (applicable only for Category D)

These documents are **required** in order to **determine** eligibility.



**You Will Not Know Unless You Apply!**

## What's Next?

You can apply throughout the year, contact your local servicing office for the current deadline.

They will let you know the status of your application, and how to carry it forward to the next funding cycle.

Funding is limited, occurs only ONCE per year, and highly competitive. Therefore, leveraging with other funding sources is **CRITICAL** and encouraged.

Eligibility does not Guarantee funding.

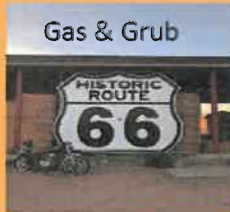
