- Legal Ram: Ram that exceeds the $\frac{3}{4}$ curl and is Greater than six (6) years old.
- Every DBS taken or any DBS horns found on the Hualapai Reservation must have affixed to one Horn, a plug seal placed by the Hualapai Game & Fish Department prior to transporting off the reservation.
- To be considered "Booked" and your name placed on a hunt priority list, you must pay a 1/3 deposit for species and hunt you want to hunt. The deposit does not guarantee price or time of the hunt.


