“SCAM ALERT”

HUALAPAI..... SCAMS are coming back up; and With A Vengeance!!! You need to be aware, and protect yourself, your family, & your finances...

The most common Scams involve people calling you and pretending to be someone you know, or someone you'd normally Trust... like the police or the Government (IRS, State Police, Sheriff's Offices). *Just hang up on them...*

REMEMBER THIS: *No law enforcement or Governmental agency will ever call you and ask you to give them your Social Security number or Bank Information. AND they WON'T tell you that you have a Warrant and will "Arrest" you...*

Another BIG Scam is through the Internet or your E-Mail... Businesses emailing you for a "bill", or "Open Immediately", OR, some recent E-mail Scams are people pretending to be from a *romantic interest* in need of help...

A few things to Remember:

- No legitimate organization will EVER have you pay a debt with a pre-paid card, like a Wal-Mart card...
- **DO NOT** give your Social Security number, and/or Name & Date of Birth to anyone who calls you...
- **NEVER** give your Bank Information over a phone or through an E-mail if someone requests it...
- Do not open suspicious texts, pop-up windows or click on links or attachments in emails – delete them...

PLEASE don't fall prey to these SCAMS. Lessen your chances of it happening by paying attention and remembering "*If It Doesn't Sound Legitimate*", do not respond. Hang Up on them IMMEDIATELY !!!
