## FIRE RESTRICTIONS CANCELLED HUALAPAI INDIAN RESERVATION

Due to reservation, widespread Monsoon precipitation within the Hualapai reservation result in decreased fire activity. All Fire Restrictions are cancelled on the Hualapai Reservation.

Please be advised, the potential for wildfires is always present and can start at any time of the year. We ask the public to be mindful of their surroundings and activities as they travel the woodland and forest on the Hualapai Reservation.

Never leave a campfire unattended, be sure it is completely out and cool to the touch before leaving.

When burning or using any equipment that may spark have a shovel and water source nearby. Avoid burning on dry and/or windy days.


Keep safety in mind when traveling into the countryside. Unseen rainy weather hides muddy conditions in backroads & wooded areas. Always inform someone of where you are going and when you expect to return.
