- 2. All Food Sale Vendors are to have Food Handler's Certification on display; all counter help and meal prep handlers included.
- 3. All Vendors to have Covid~19 Vaccination Cards available. (not mandatory).
- 4. Vendor set-up location will be assigned.
- 5. All vendors will unload and move vehicles away from the parking area. Parking can be along the multi building, across multi building or at Training Center.
- 6. Vendors with children are to keep kids from running around other vendor table displays. Please be mindful of others property and personal belongings.
- 7. ALL VENDORS ARE TO FOLLOW CDC/HUALAPAI TRIBE REGULATIONS AND PROTOCOL DUE TO THE COVID~19 VIRUS.
- 8. Hand Sanitizer should be made available for consumers.
- 9. At the end of the bazaar all vendors are to clean up and dispose of trash, spills and wipe down tables and chairs.
