GRAND CANYON – The Hualapai Tribal Forestry has learned that the Grand Canyon National Park Service (NPS) will be conducting Prescribed Burn activities north of the Hualapai Reservation beginning on Saturday morning, October 8, 2022. These operations may be going on through October 22, 2022, and are located on the Arizona Strip between Grand Canyon National Park and the Nevada border near Mt. Dellenbaugh.

Please be advised that at this time there is no danger to the Reservation. Engine Crews & Fire Personnel from Hualapai Wildland Fire Management are available locally in the event there is any activity on the Reservation

Recent moisture has diminished drought conditions in our area; however, threats are always present. For your protection, continue to remain alert and always be safe in your surroundings while you enjoy your local forests and woodlands.
