Verizon Cell Site Leases on Hualapai Reservation

Verizon has approached tribal council to renew their existing cell site leases on the Hualapai Reservation.

What?

Verizon has offered to pay the tribe \$30,000 per year for each site for the next 10 years or \$600,000 in all.

When?

Tribal council appointed a new Election Board to hold the Special Election this year.

Why?

Article V.n of the <u>Hualapai Constitution</u> says that leases involving more than \$50,000 shall need the approval of the eligible voters of the Tribe voting in a Special Election.

Verizon is upgrading their network connection to the internet (backhaul) and should be complete in the first part of 2024.

Approval of the new leases will give Verizon the "green light" to upgrade to 5G service to improve the speed of your hand-held devices by the end of 2024.
