Description of the VERIZON TOWERS PROJECT.

Verizon seeks to renew their existing cell site leases on the Hualapai Tribal Reservation.

Verizon has offered to pay the tribe \$30,000 per year for each site for the next 10 years or \$600,000 in all.

Verizon is upgrading their network connection to the internet (backhaul) and should be complete in the first part of 2024.

Approval for the new lease will give Verizon the “green light” to upgrade to 5G service to improve the speed of your hand-held devices by the end of 2024.

Site of the leases on Hualapai Reservation are; Canyon Vista Site along Buck & Doe Road & Gray Mountain Site north of the Route 66.
